Palestine 101

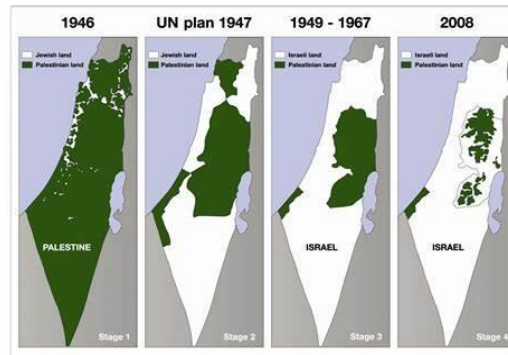
“According to a 2017 report by Addameer, over the past 50 years, more than 800,000 Palestinians have been imprisoned or detained by Israel, this figure is now believed to be closer to 1 million. This means that about 40% of Palestinian men and boys living under military occupation have been deprived of their freedom. Almost every Palestinian family has suffered the imprisonment of a loved one.” – [BDS Movement](#)

Palestinian children are the only children (boys and girls) in the world who are systematically prosecuted in military courts, with an estimated 10,000 Palestinian children held in the Israeli military detention system over the past 20 years. – [Save the Children](#)

Unnoticed Events in 2023

“As Palestinian Muslims gathered for Ramadan prayers [2023] exercising their right to worship in Al-Aqsa Mosque [third holiest site in Islam], Israeli authorities used blatantly excessive and unjustified force [stun grenades, tear gas, indiscriminately beat Muslim worshippers – including elderly and women – with batons and rifle butts, and arrested at least 450 men] against them.” – [Francesca Albanese, UN Special Rapporteur, Occupied Palestinian Territory](#)

[June 21st, 2023] The Israeli Cabinet gives Bezalel Smotrich sole power to construct 4 500 new illegal settlements on Palestinian land [in the West Bank]. – [Jewish Voice for Peace](#)



Three settler related incidents per day [in the West Bank] occurred on average in the first eight months of 2023 [killing 189 and injuring 8 192 Palestinians, damaging their property/homes, and preventing them from travelling.] – [UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs \(OCHA\)](#)

Resisting the Occupation

“[O]ver 150 Palestinians have been killed in the [2018 peaceful] demonstrations. At least 10 000 others have been injured, including 1 849 children, 424 women, 115 paramedics and 115 journalists. Of those injured, 5 814 were hit by live ammunition. – [Al Mezan Centre for Human Rights](#)

UNGA Resolution 37/43 (1982) reaffirmed the “inalienable right” of the Palestinian people “and all peoples under foreign and colonial domination” to self-determination. It also reaffirmed the legitimacy of “the struggle of peoples for [...] liberation from colonial and foreign domination and foreign occupation by all available means, including armed struggle. – [United Nations General Assembly](#)
